An Organ fanfare of welcome followed with the singing of Ave Maria (The Thirteenth of May) as Mgr. John Armitage receives the Statue in this Centenary Year of the Apparitions along with the Relics of St. Francisco and St. Jacinta.

Helpful Information for the Retreat

The Pilgrimage Retreat programme is run throughout the entire time of the Our Lady of Fatima Visitation as people will come for certain days and times. During the time of the Pilgrimage Retreat there will be Fatima books and items available for sale in the Pilgrim Hall behind the Chapel of Our Lady of Reconciliation. You will also learn about Enrolment in the Brown Scapular and the importance of the Five First Saturdays all connected with the messages of Our Lady of Fatima. The World Apostolate of Fatima UK Team will be around to talk to you and teach about aspects of the Message of Fatima which you may like to have deeper knowledge of.

Enrolment in the Brown Scapular - this will happen at various times when need arises.
